- **Aim:**
 - To develop the scope and impact of Manchester Motivational Interviewing Network (MMIN) by developing and embedding MI practice across a range of professional sectors (e.g., education; health; social care; probation; counselling);
 - To improve outcomes for a wide range of clients.
- **Length:** 3-years (September 2017 to August 2020).
